APOLLOS SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATIONS DUE APRIL 15

Eligibility Requirements:

An Apollos applicant must be:

1. An individual who possesses qualities of excellence for ministry
2. A member of a Presbyterian Church (USA) congregation
3. Currently under the care of a Presbytery as an Inquirer or a Candidate
4. Accepted or enrolled as a full-time student in the Master of Divinity, Master of Arts or Dual degree program in one of the 10 Presbyterian seminaries.

Application Process and Requirements

The Apollos application instructions must be followed in their entirety.

A complete application consists of the following components:

1. A completed five-page application.
2. An official transcript of records from universities where his/her degree(s) are conferred.

Each transcript should be in an official sealed envelope from the registrar's office.

We can also accept transcripts from universities via electronic services, email or fax.

We can NOT accept transcripts sent to us directly by seminary students.

3. An official transcript of seminary records if currently enrolled. The transcript should be in a sealed envelope from the registrar's office. We can also accept transcripts from seminaries via electronic services, email or fax.
4. Three non-family references on the required Reference Questionnaire forms in sealed envelopes.
